



How to view forum statistics?

 The Statistics differs from the Activity Report in that Statistics presents data based on the posts. The activity report presents data based on the students.

When you enter the Forum tool, you will be able to see the **Statistics** option.

The statistics page shows the following information:

- **Overview** shows a graph that displays the number of post or reply to a post within a range of time. You can set your own **date range** when viewing this graph.
- **Trending Posts** lists down the thread from the highest engagement score to the lowest. Engagement score is calculated from the number of replies plus followers / subscribers.
- **Top Rated Posts** list down the threads that receive any rating. The student column shows the average rating given by students who rated the post, while the instructor column shows the average rating given by instructors who rated the post. The average rating score column shows the average rating from students and instructors.
- **Most Active Users** will list down users from the most active to the least.
