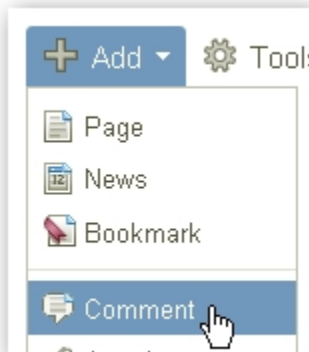


Add comments to a wiki page

If you are using the wiki to come up with a collaborative document, you may want to use the comments function which is available on each page or blog post (if you have been provided permission to add comments).

- To comment, mouseover **Add**, then click **Comment**. Alternatively, scroll to the bottom of the page and click the **Add comment** text link.



- Write your comment, then click **Post**.
