Device Minimum System Requirements



The Examplify version officially supported by NUS is 3.4.6 for Windows and 3.4.4 for Mac. Please check and ensure you are using the correct version of Examplify before your exam.

If your Examplify version is wrong, upgrade your Examplify by following the below steps:

- 1. Remove the downloaded exam file (How do I remove downloaded exam file from Examplify?), if any.
- 2. Download the Examplify installer (Download and Install Examplify) and install it over your current Examplify.
- 3. Take a few practice exams to ensure that the new Examplify works fine on your device.
- 4. Download or re-download your exam file.
